

**Town of Amberg**  
**Special Town Board Meeting Minutes**  
Thursday, 25 July, 5:00 pm

Chairman Mattison called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm with Supervisor Werner, Supervisor Holmes, Clerk Boshen, and 2 community members present.

The order of the agenda was revised to allow closed session discussion on a temporary hire.

Mattison asked for further discussion on the pickup truck purchase that was approved at the last board meeting stating that a new plow would cost about \$4750.00 without shoes or a rubber shield from Elias auto. New plow shoes would cost about \$140.00. After a brief discussion and clarification of some of the terms of the agreement the board unanimously agreed to uphold the motion to purchase the 1 ton pickup truck from Ken Mattison.

Clerk Boshen asked that the Town Board look at the feasibility of a website with the understanding that it would have a minimal yearly cost to the town and be an excellent tool. After a brief discussion she was given permission to bring a demo web page to the next regular board meeting for further discussion.

Chairman Mattison stated that the Town Road department is falling behind in the normal summer projects they do and there is a need for a temporary employee to help pick up the slack. After discussion on what work needs to be accomplished, the wages to be offered, and the possibility of paying unemployment, Supervisor Werner made a motion to hire a temporary worker for not more than twelve weeks with a second by Mattison. The vote was unanimous.

Supervisor Holmes made a motion to adjourn into closed session to look at existing job applications and discuss the availability and/or possibility of hiring one of the applicants. Supervisor Werner seconded the motion and the board adjourned into closed session.

**CLOSED SESSION**

Board members reviewed the job applications on file. Supervisor Werner, with a second by Chairman Mattison made a motion, that contingent upon availability, and the answers received about several unemployment questions, Chris Schoon will be offered a short term employment on an as needed basis. Supervisor Holmes abstained from voting.

Supervisor Werner, seconded by Supervisor Holmes made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:05 pm. Unanimous.
